Action required at this meeting – the Programme Coordinating Board is invited to: *elect* officers for the period 1 January 2014 to 31 December 2014 and to approve the composition of the PCB NGOs.

Cost implications for decisions: *none*

- 1. In accordance with the Modus Operandi of the Programme Coordinating Board (paragraph 22), the Board is expected to elect from among its members, and States elected as members as of 1 January 2014, a chair, a vice chair and a rapporteur.
- 2. The Modus Operandi foresees the Programme Coordinating Board to elect the current vice chair, Australia, to the position of chair for a term starting on 1 January, 2014. This meeting of the Programme Coordinating Board must also elect a vice chair and a rapporteur for a term of one year starting on 1 January, 2014.
- 3. In doing so, the attention of the Programme Coordinating Board is drawn to paragraph 22 of the Modus Operandi which states that: "Officers will be elected taking into account a fair geographical distribution."
- 4. Under the provisions of the Modus Operandi, the following Member States will be eligible for election as an officer of the Board on the basis that they will be members starting 1 January, 2014:

1. Australia 12. Kazakhstan 2. Belaium 13. Morocco 3. Brazil 14. Denmark 4. China 15. Poland 5. Congo 16. Sierra Leone 6. El Salvador 17. Switzerland

- 5. It should be noted that in accordance with the Modus Operandi (paragraph 22), for States elected as a member as of 1 January 2014 a written statement of interest is required to be elected as an officer. The Secretariat has received (on 13 December) from the Africa Group coordinator, the nomination of Zimbabwe for the office of vice -chair for 2014. At time of this report, no expression of interest has been received for the post of rapporteur.
- 6. In accordance with paragraph 2b of the Annex of ECOSOC Resolution 1995/2:
 - "(b) The process of identification of the non-governmental organizations that sought to participate in the work of the Board would be determined by the non-governmental organizations themselves. The Board would formally approve the nomination of those organizations;"
