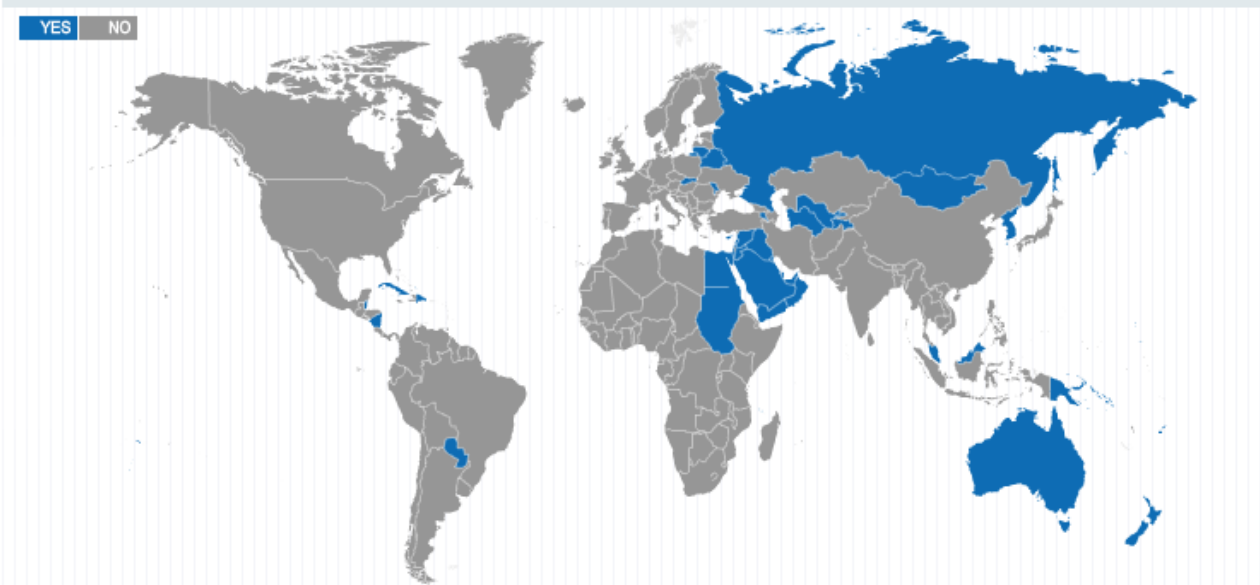

- **5 countries** deny visas for even short term stays:

Qatar
Singapore
Turks and Caicos Islands

- **22 countries** deport individuals once their HIV-positive status is discovered:
