The Joint United Nations Programme on HIV/AIDS (UNAIDS) presents its compliments to the Permanent Missions in Geneva, to organizations of the United Nations system, and to nongovernmental organizations dealing with matters pertaining to HIV/AIDS not represented on the UNAIDS Programme Coordinating Board (PCB).

UNAIDS has the honour to inform the Missions and organizations that the forty-fourth meeting of the Board will be held from 25 to 27 June 2019 at the Starling Geneva Hotel & Conference Center, 34 route François-Peyrot, Geneva. The meeting will begin at 09:00 on 25 June with registration starting at 08:15. The meeting is scheduled to finish on 27 June at 18:00.

A copy of the provisional agenda and a note on logistical arrangements for the forty-fourth meeting of the UNAIDS PCB meeting can be found on the UNAIDS website. Simultaneous interpretation will be provided for the UNAIDS PCB plenary sessions in Arabic, Chinese, English, French, Russian and Spanish. Documents are being prepared in English and in French and will be available on the UNAIDS website closer to the meeting dates.

UNAIDS wishes to draw the attention of the Missions and organizations to the Modus Operandi of the UNAIDS PCB, which includes a provision that observer status may be granted by the Executive Director of UNAIDS, in consultation with the PCB Chairperson and upon receipt of a written application expressing a manifest interest, to any Member State of any of the UNAIDS cosponsoring organizations, and any intergovernmental or nongovernmental organization. Observers shall make their own arrangements to cover expenses incurred in attending meetings of the UNAIDS Board including any visa requirements. To facilitate logistical arrangements, applications for observer status should be submitted online using the electronic registration form available under the following link: http://pcbregistration.unaids.org before the 14 June 2019 deadline.
