STEP ONE – Log into our Platform

1. Supported browser



- 2. It is highly recommended to open a new private window in Google Chrome.
- 3. Copy paste the link sent by email from PCBgovernance@unaids.org
- 4. Sign in using the credentials provided by email.

STEP TWO - How to use our Platform

1. To request the floor, ask for a permission to speak by clicking the green hand icon to raise your hand



2. Don't worry if you cannot see yourself in the ALL speakers list. In the moment when you raise a hand, request will be visible on chairman list.



3. When Chairman allows your streaming, following message is received. Select video in order to stream both, audio and video.

4. Use the Disconnect button to stop your streaming. Red means you are streaming, green means that you are not streaming.



5. If the interpretation language is selected when the interpreter is muted, user hears Floor, and when interpreter is speaking, user hears interpreting. This way, participant does not need to switch between channels and only hears the language he/she understands, either on the Floor or through the interpreter

6. Watch, listen and talk to the other participants. Watch presentations and/or video feeds from other participants. Choose full screen (Hover the mouse over the video and icon will become visible)



7. Share your screen, app window or browser tab.

8. Use EVENT CHAT to communicate with other participants and moderators.

9. POINT OF ORDER

If remote delegate wishes to intervene and stop delegate that is currently speaking, PRIVATE CHAT with Chairman should be used so the floor request can be escalated immediately (Bottom right corner – blue circle with exclamation mark).



STEP THREE - Troubleshooting

1. Use following link if you are not able to connect or if getting any error messages when trying to stream your audio and video <u>https://interpret.world/test</u>
