Your Technical and Financial proposals each be accompanied by a Proposal Submission and Acceptance Form (Annex 4 of the RFP), endorsing that the proposal meets the requirements of the RFP and specifying the number of days the proposal is valid (from the date of closing of the RFP).

UNAIDS will open the technical proposals in the presence of a Committee formed by UNAIDS at the Headquarters office in Geneva, Switzerland on 10 January 2011 at 10.00hrs Geneva time in the UNAIDS premises. Bidders wishing to attend the session (at their own cost) should inform UNAIDS in advance via email (to the address specified in section 2.6 of the RFP).

4. Evaluation of Proposals: Proposals will be evaluated in two stages, with technical evaluation being completed prior to any evaluation of the financial proposal.

Short-listed bidders, at the final stage of the technical evaluation, will be requested to make a presentation by video conference, webinar or teleconference.

5. All evaluation of proposals and the selection of vendors will be in accordance with the specifications of the RFP.
