

Answers to questions from Potential Bidders RFP-2011-38 - Development of partnerships and cross cutting competency training modules: Phase 1 01-Sep-2011

1. The requested proposal concerns Phase 1 (development of the face-to-face workshop). Is it envisaged that the 3-day workshop covers all 6 competencies, or is the development of more workshops each covering 2 or 3 competencies an option to be considered.
