USB Flash Drives for the Washington Report

Q1: Is UNAIDS interested in a custom software solution?

Answer 1: No. All files should be placed in folders supplied, on the USB stick root directory, in order to be accessible through Microsoft Windows Explorer on a PC or similar programme on other computer systems.

Q2: We have reviewed the specifications and understand that we will also need to provide a lanyard clipped to the USB Flash Drives. However, there are no specifications listed for the Lanyards. We will need to know: What width are the lanyards? What type of material and color material are the lanyards? How many colors to the lanyards Imprint?

Answer 2: Please refer to the ITB for specifications of the lanyards. Page 7 states:

Lanyard: Fabric material with a minimum of 15mm wide and 90cm loop. Black color. Printed with at least 8mm tall, in white lowercase text "unaids.org". Plastic or metal clasp that securely fits the USB (or which includes a mobile phone strap securing the USB). Lanyard to be connected to the USB prior to delivery.
