


INVEST IN ENDING AIDS

US\$ 29 billion a year by 2025 will provide for comprehensive HIV services, people-centred, context-specific service integration and the removal of societal and legal impediments to creating an enabling environment for HIV services. Investing fully will lead to preventing hundreds of thousands of AIDS-related deaths and averting millions of new HIV infections.

The US\$ 29 billion will be invested in:

COMPREHENSIVE HIV SERVICES



- ▶ HIV testing
- ▶ Antiretroviral therapy for adults
- ▶ Viral load testing
- ▶ Retention support for people on treatment



- ▶ HIV testing and treatment of pregnant women
- ▶ Early infant diagnosis
- ▶ Paediatric treatment



- ▶ Pre-exposure prophylaxis



- ▶ Condoms, lubricants and other commodities



- ▶ Voluntary medical male circumcision



- ▶ Services for people who inject drugs
- ▶ Opioid substitution therapy
- ▶ Needle-syringe programmes



- ▶ Comprehensive sexuality education
- ▶ Economic empowerment of adolescent girls and young women
- ▶ Services for adolescent girls and young women
