KEY MESSAGES

- People have to be at the centre of UHC
- UHC is a direction, not an end result. The goal is to apply systems thinking for a comprehensive problem-solving approach
- It is crucial to remove legal barriers and ensure that health-relevant services are people-centred, rights-based, gender sensitive, and promote inclusive health governance
- Human rights must guide UHC

KEY MESSAGES – Cont'd

- Invest in HIV as part of overall health financing
- It is possible to expand HIV services to cover multiple health service needs of People living with HIV. Integration will contribute to better health outcomes for people. Similarly, facilities for general health services can also be used to provide HIV service, provided staff are well oriented to provide key population friendly services combined with engagement of key populations in service provision
