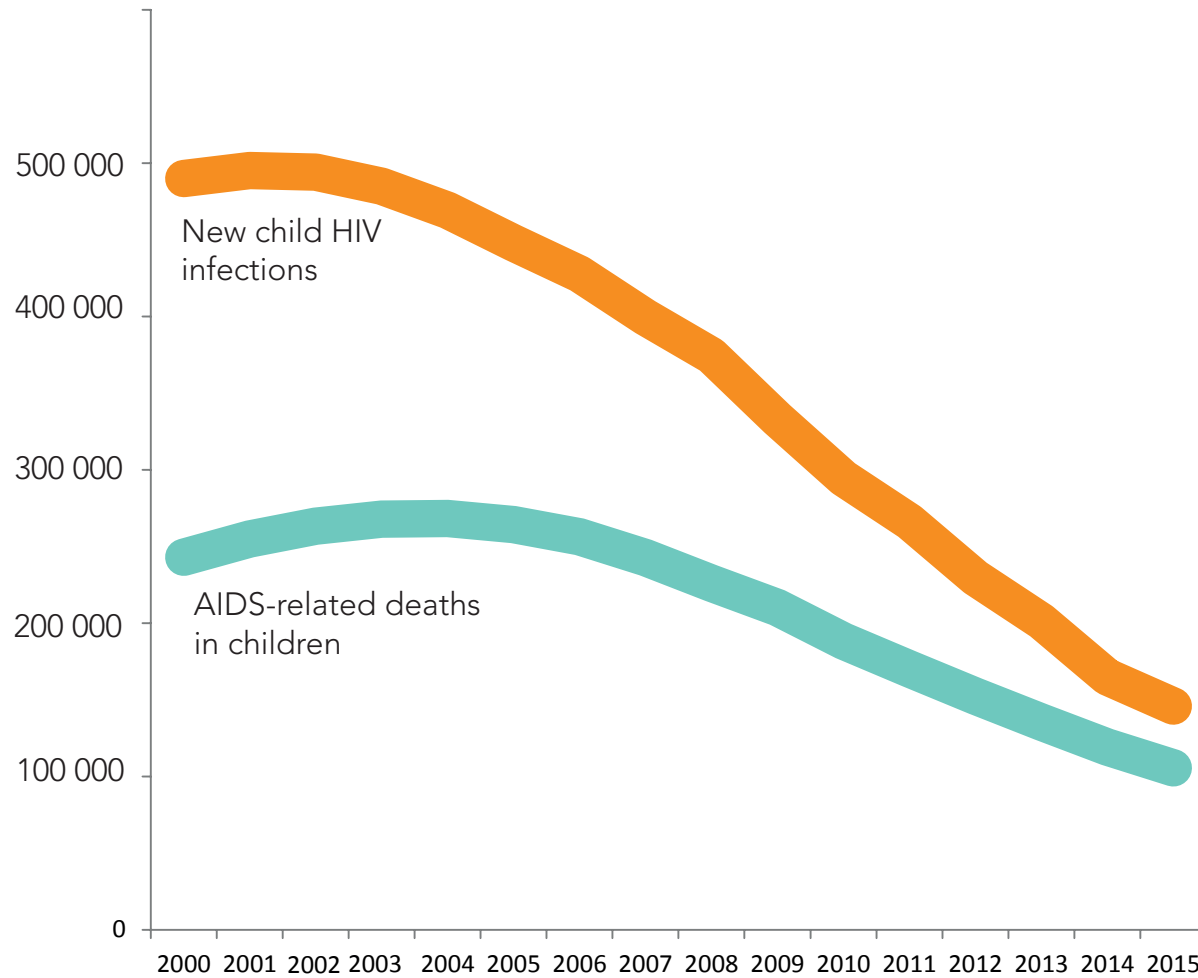

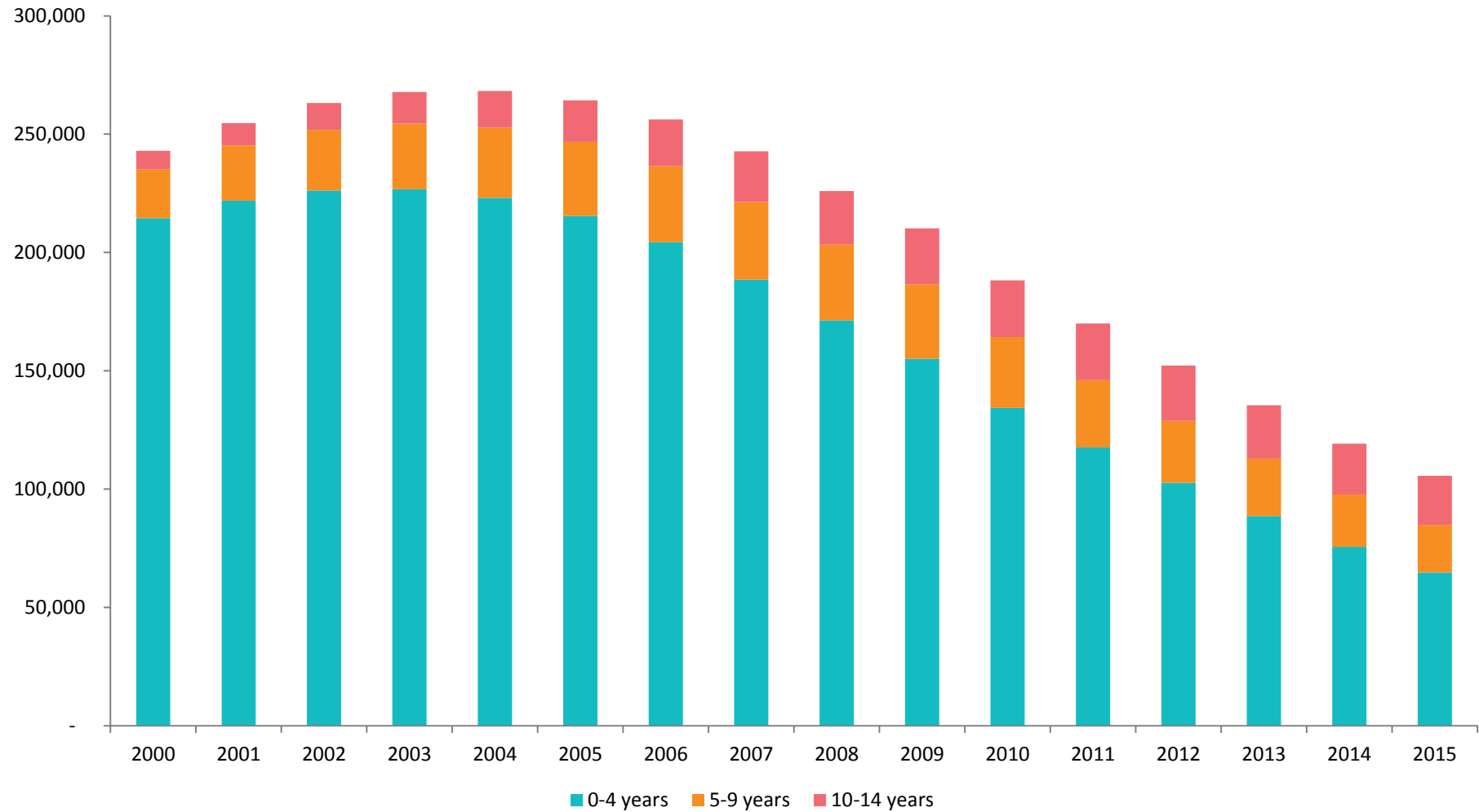

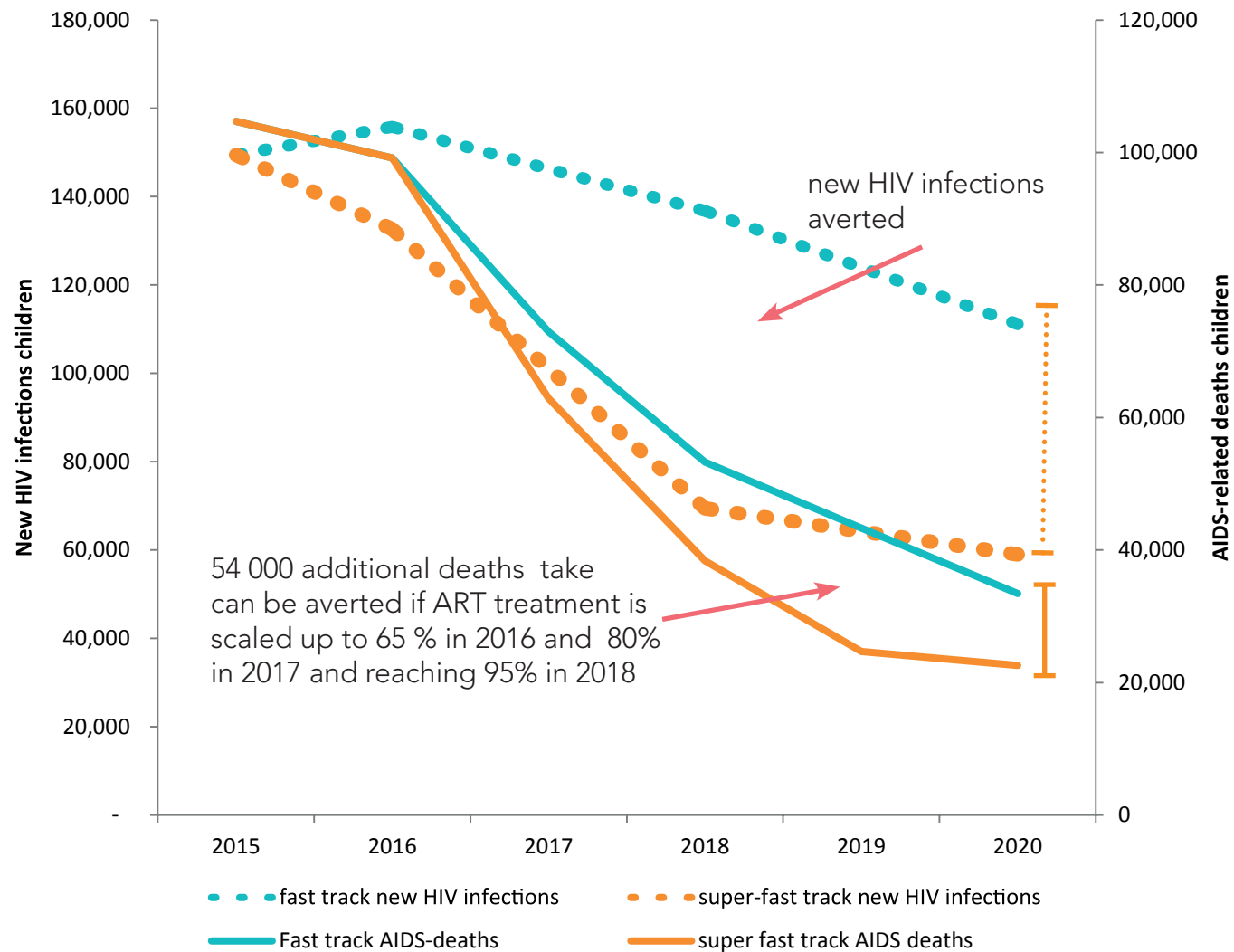

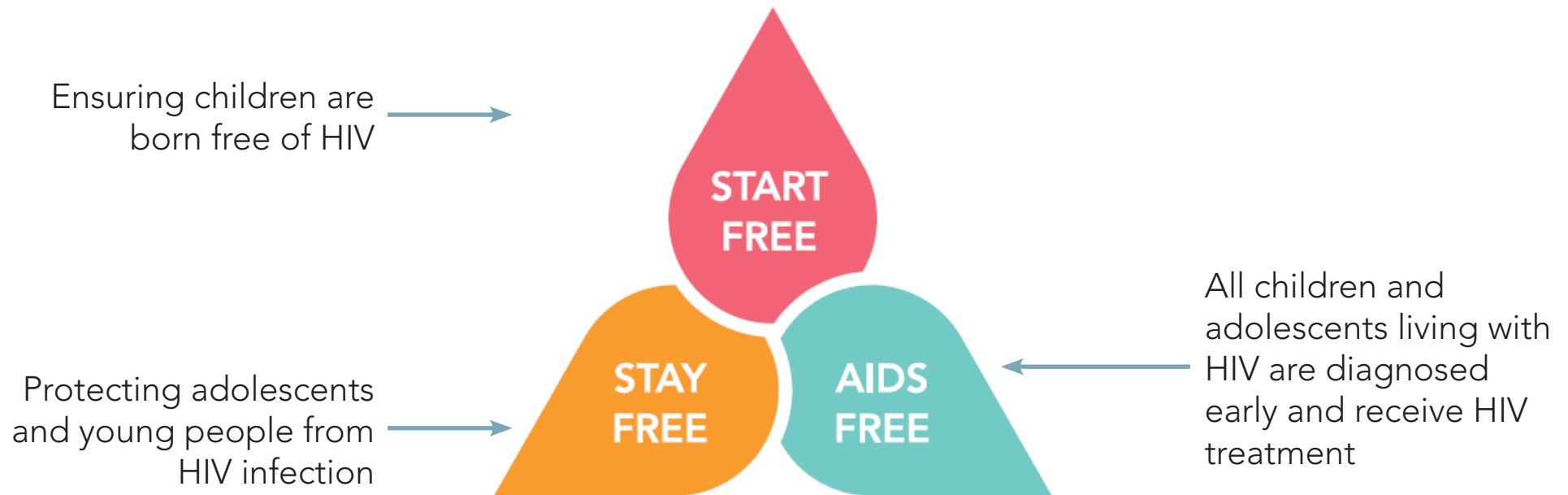

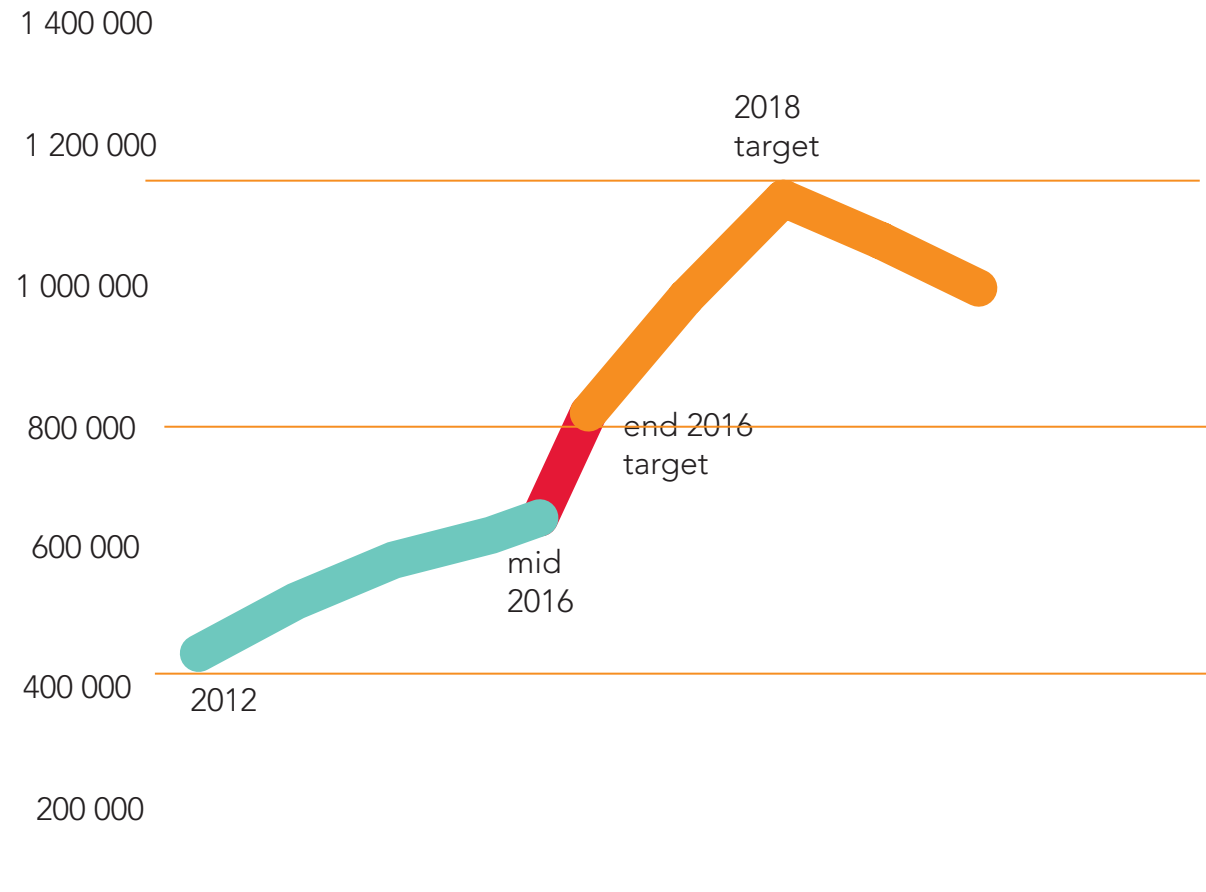


THE LIFE-CYCLE APPROACH



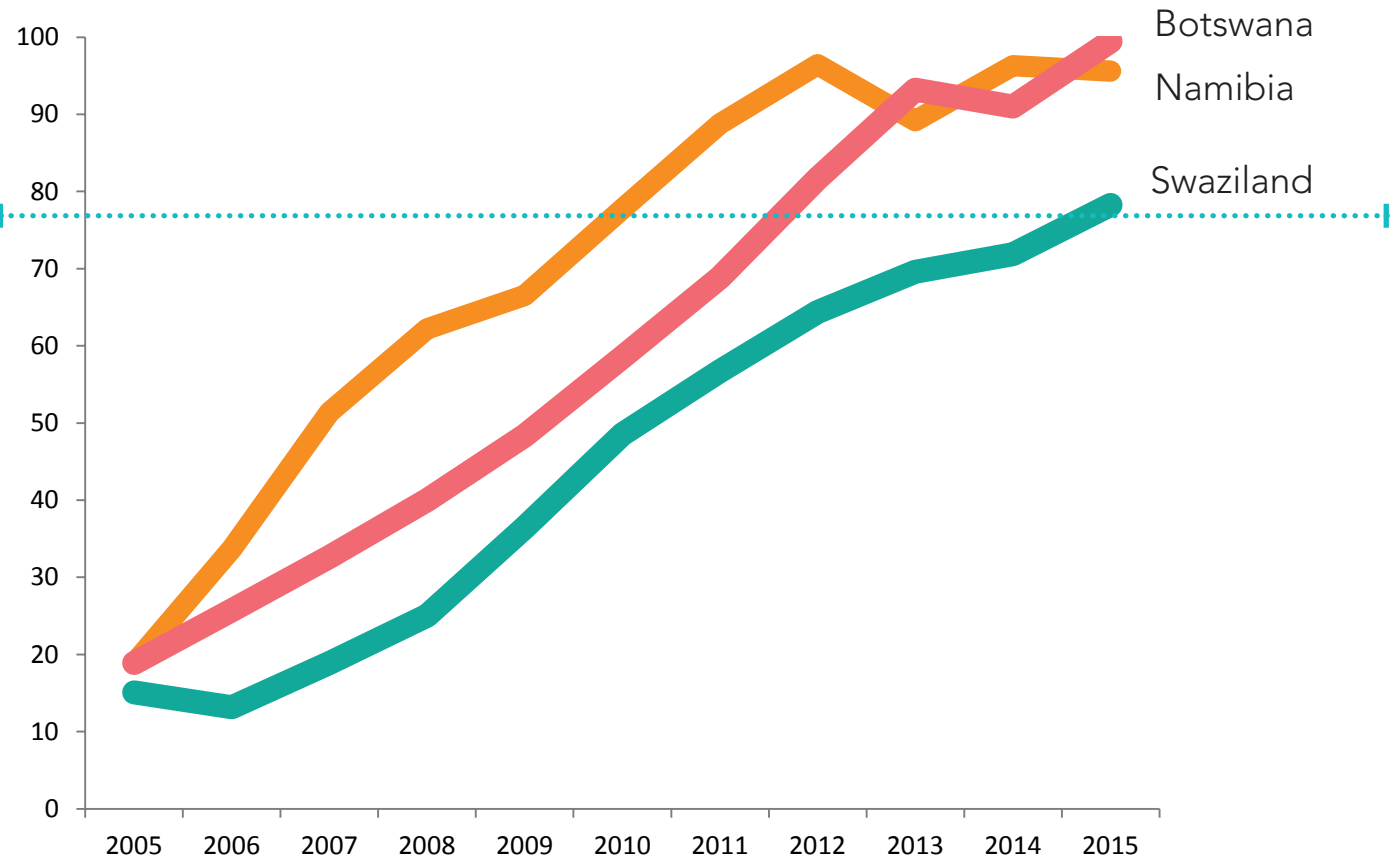

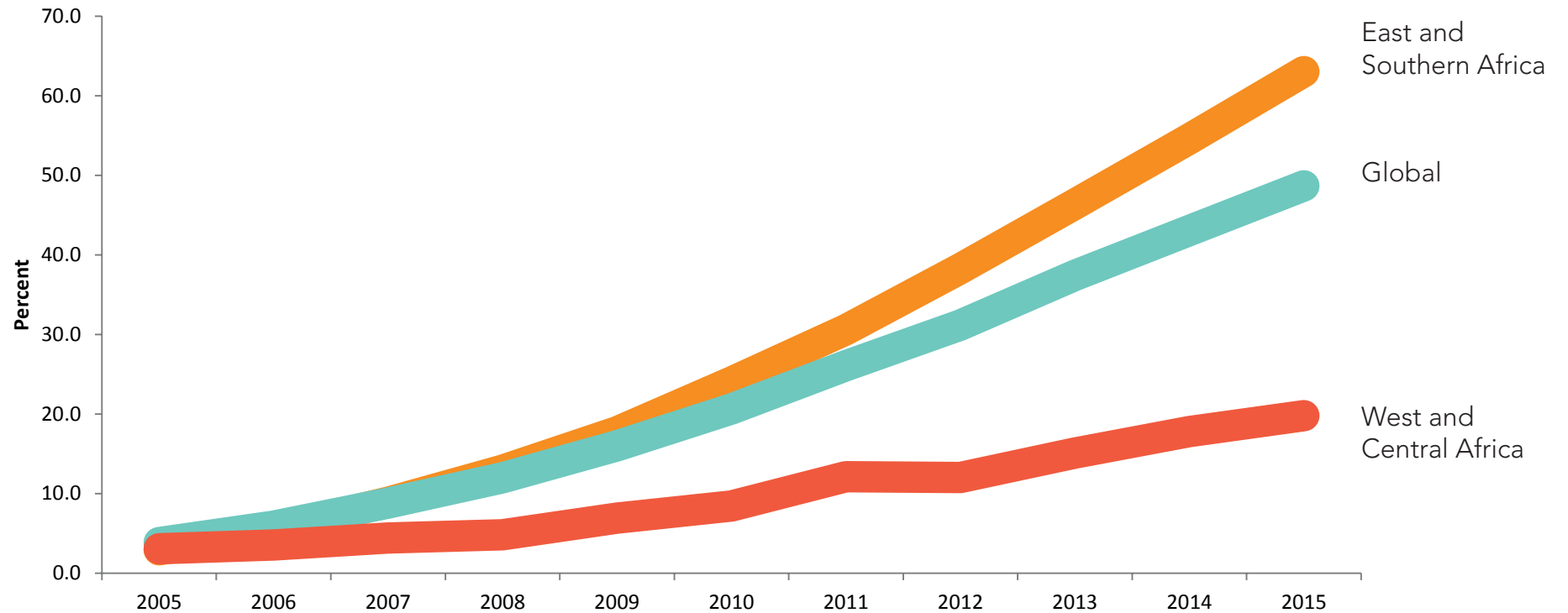

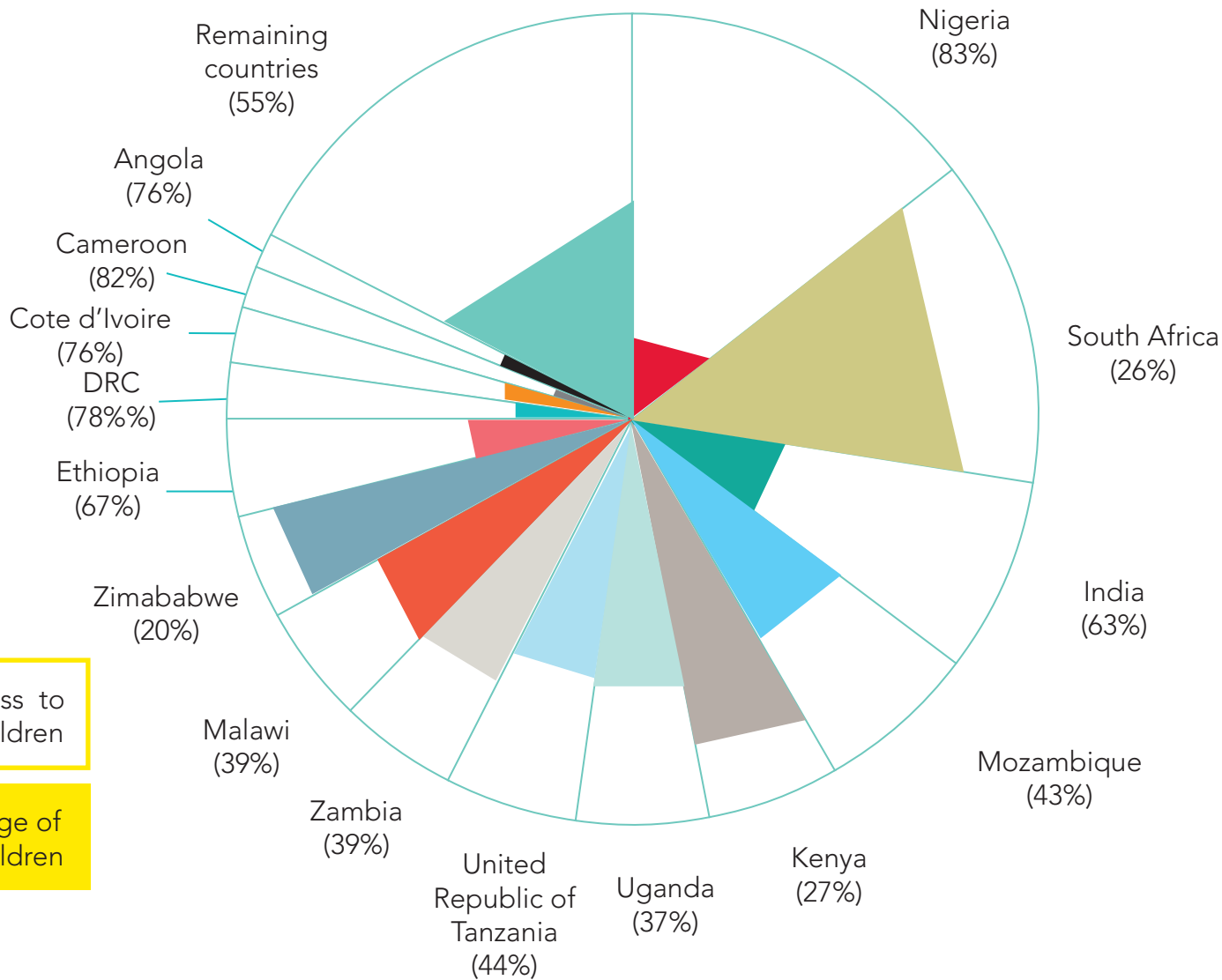
PERCENTAGE OF CHILDREN LIVING WITH HIV ON ART

PERCENTAGE OF CHILDREN RECEIVING ANTIRETROVIRAL THERAPY, 2005- 2016

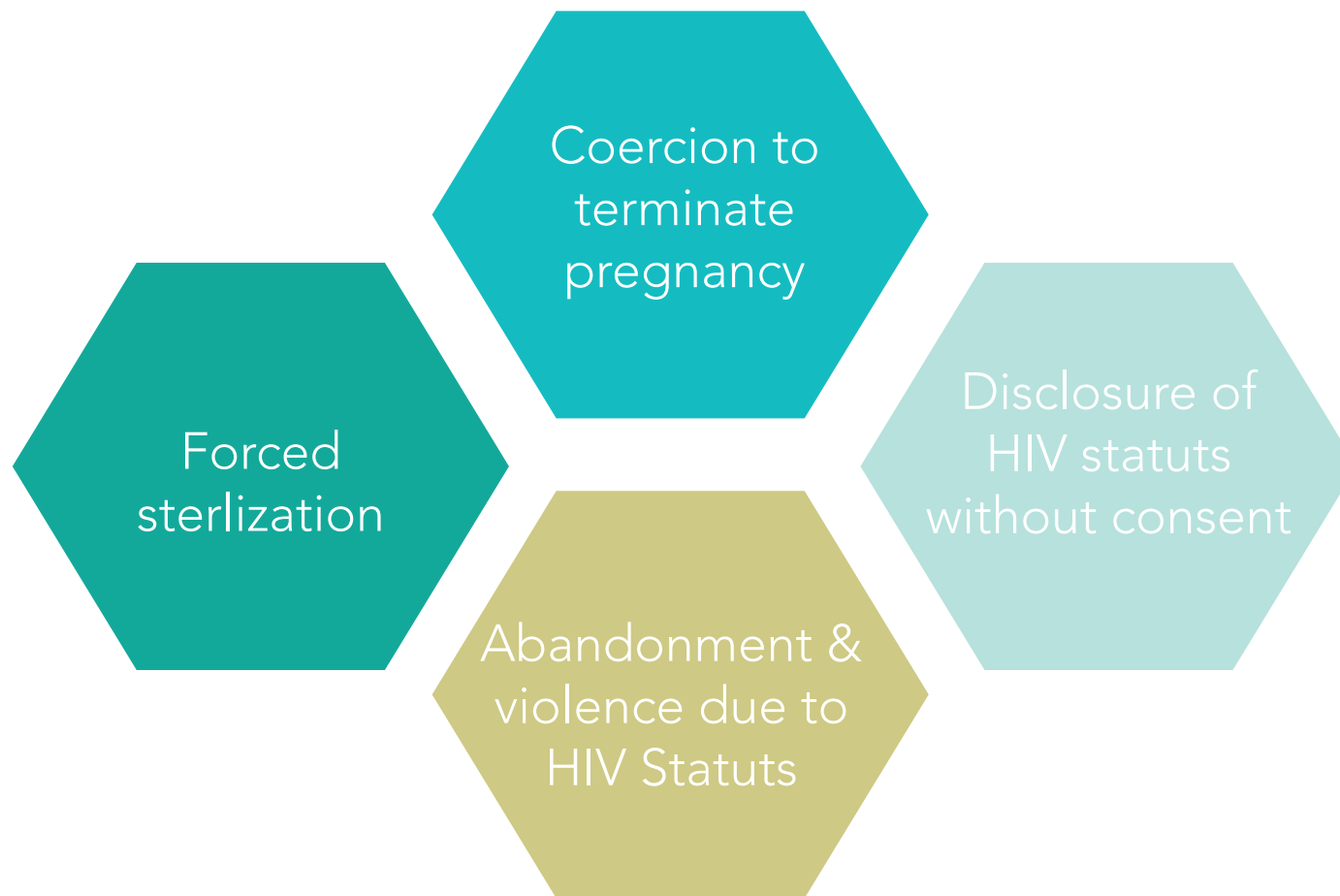
GAPS IN ACCESS TO TREATMENT FOR CHILDREN LIVING WITH HIV
