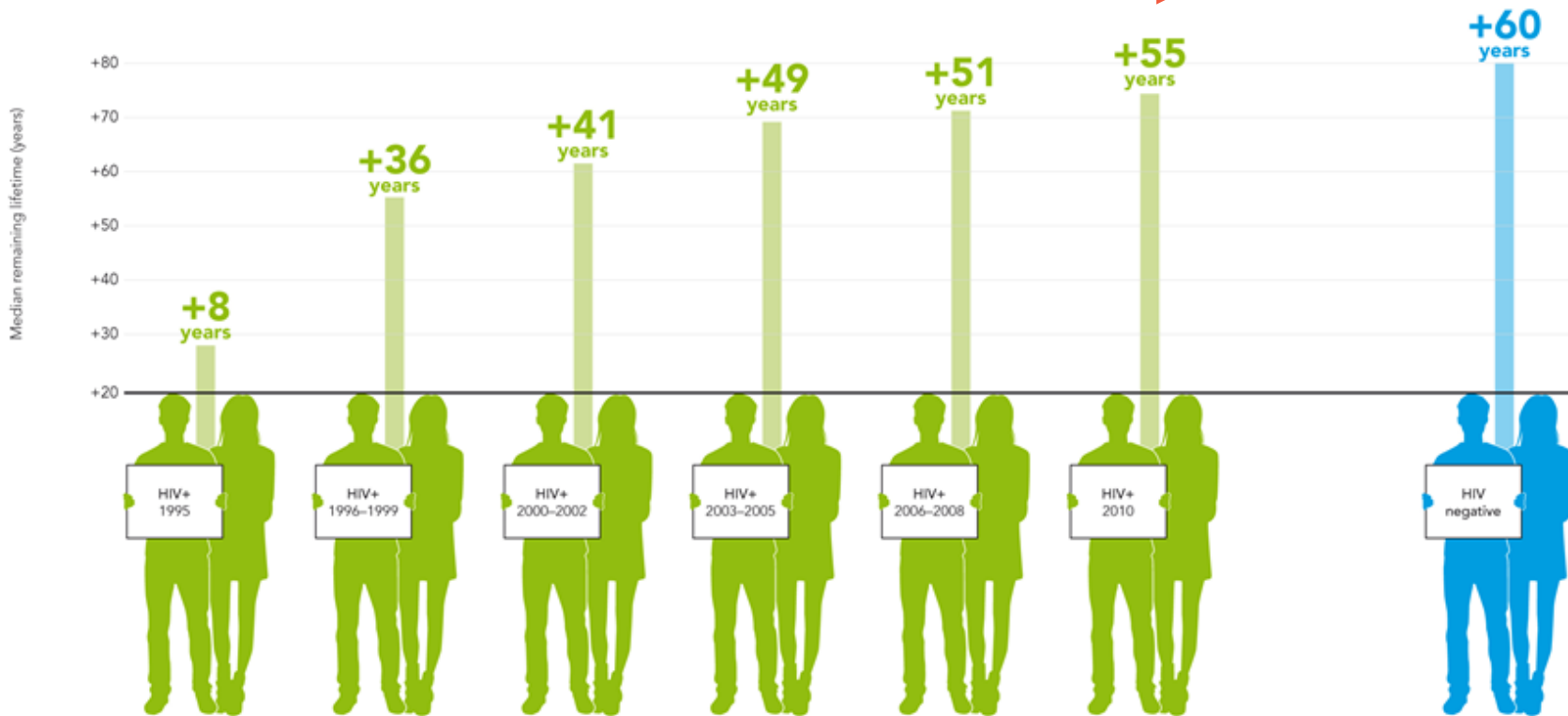

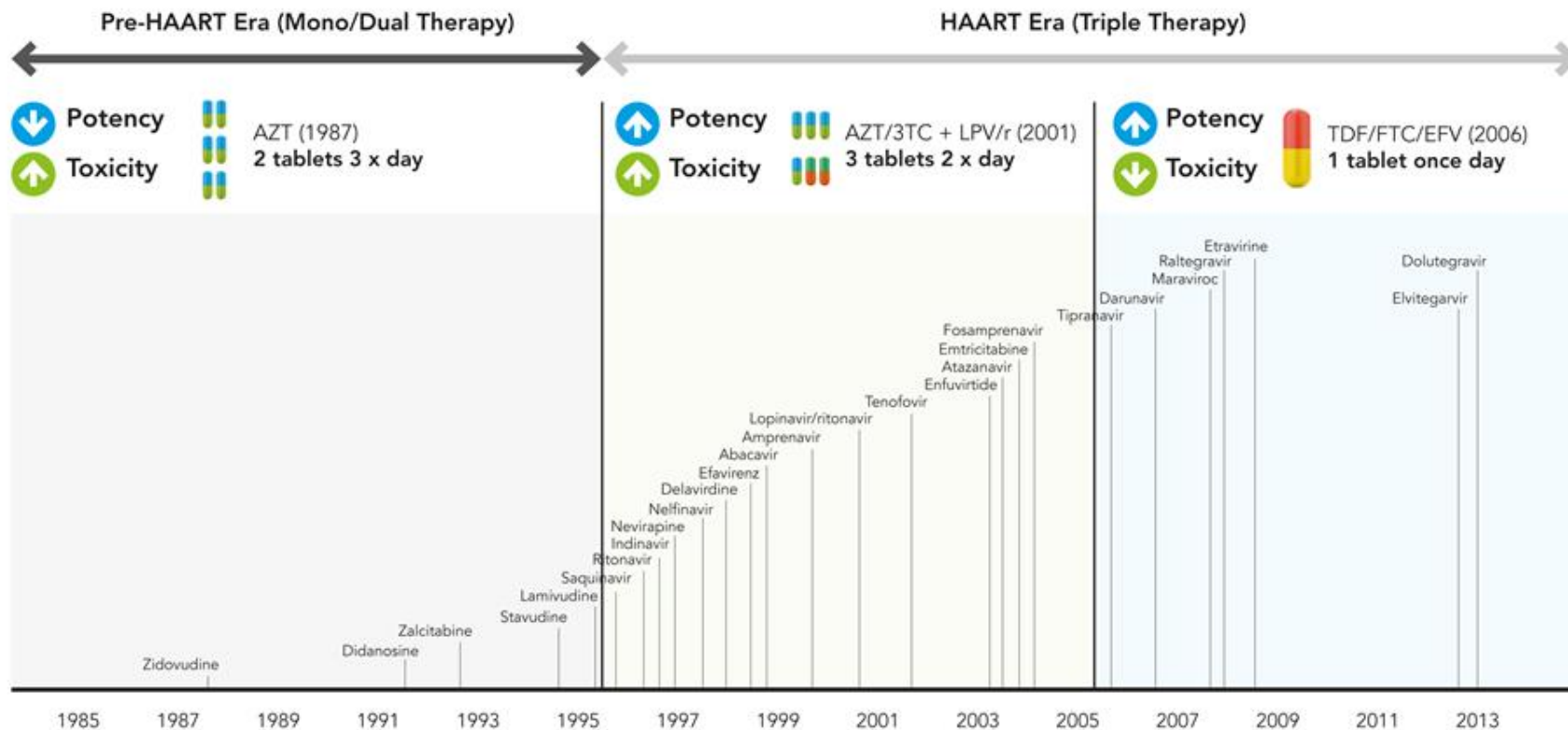

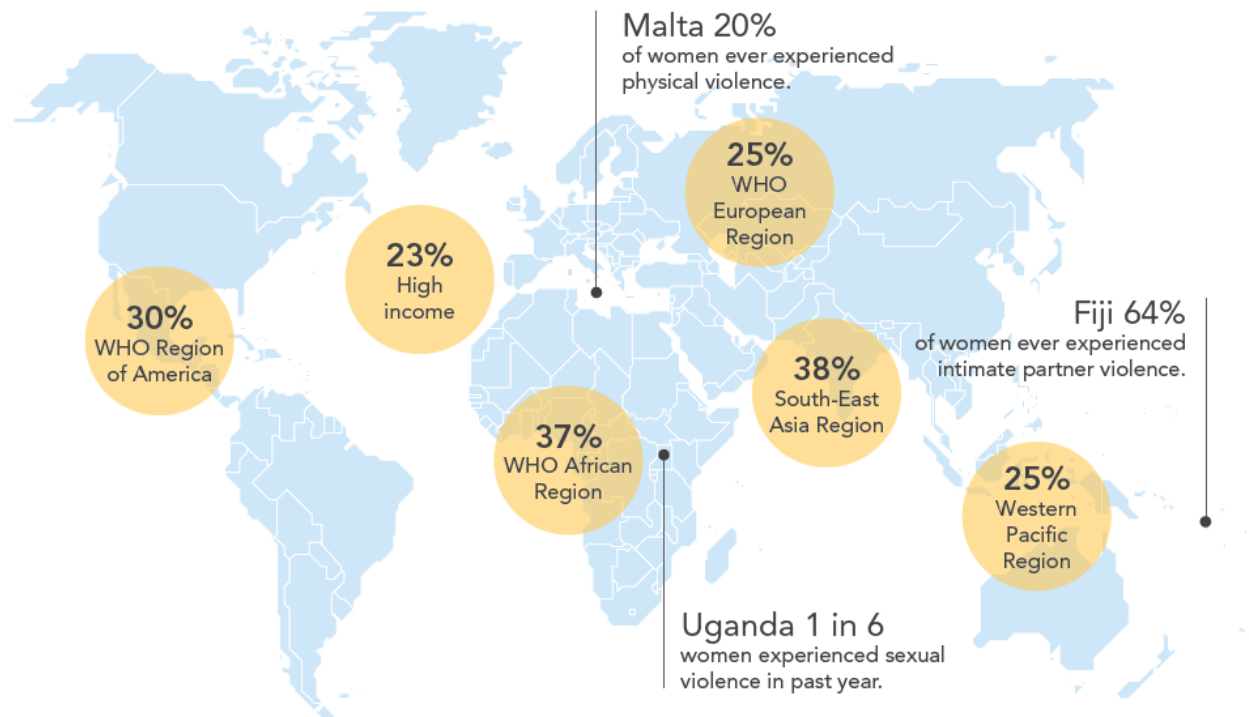

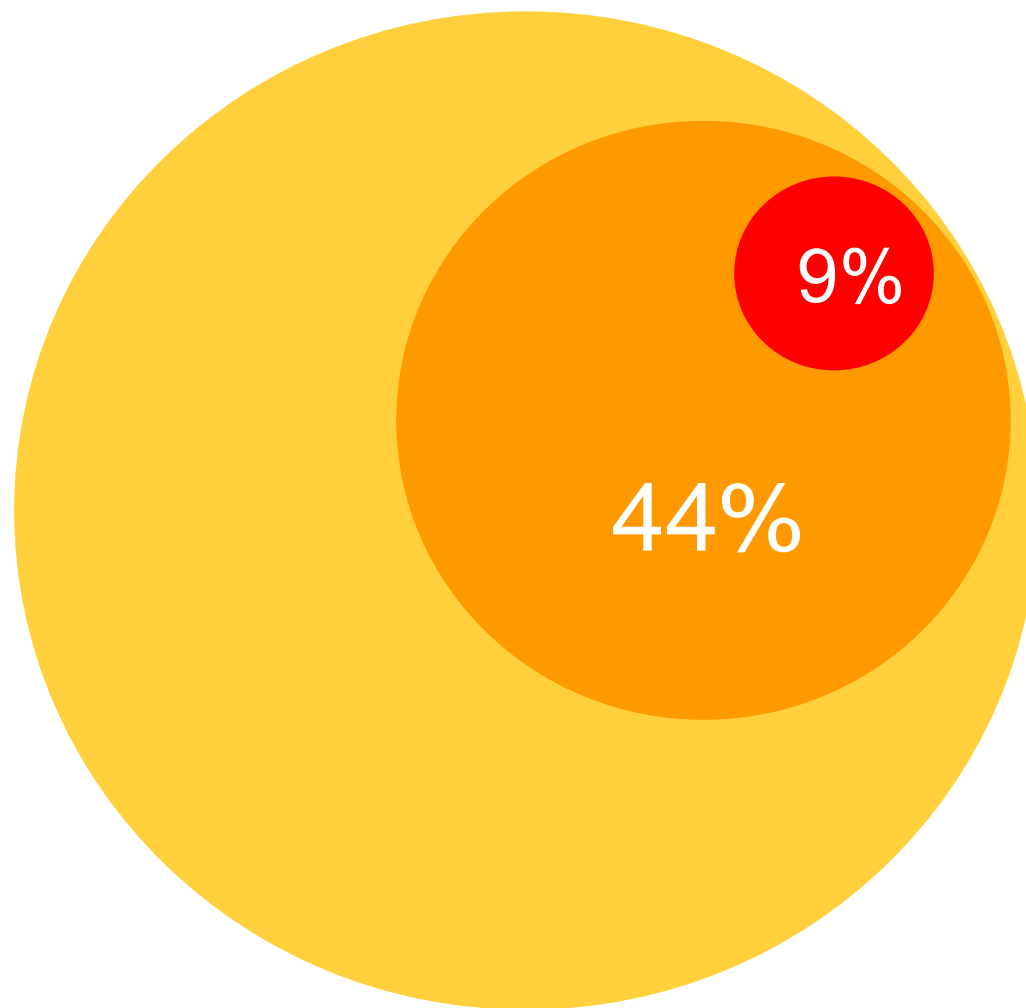

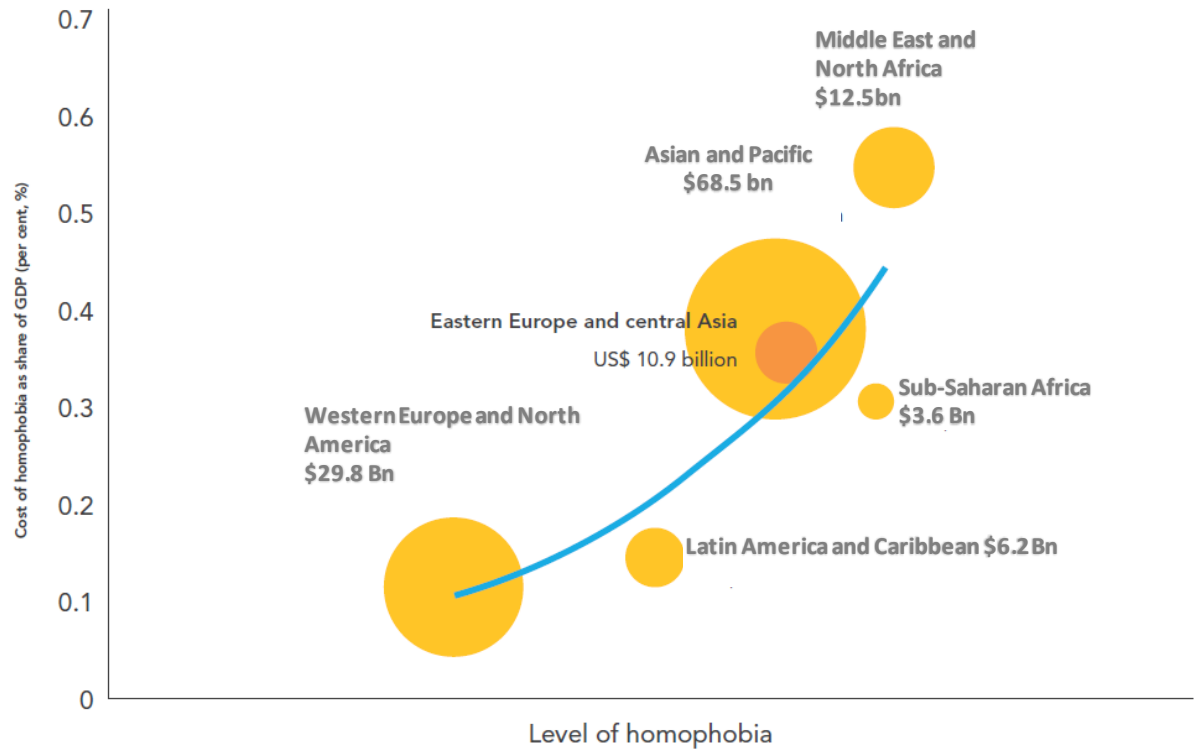

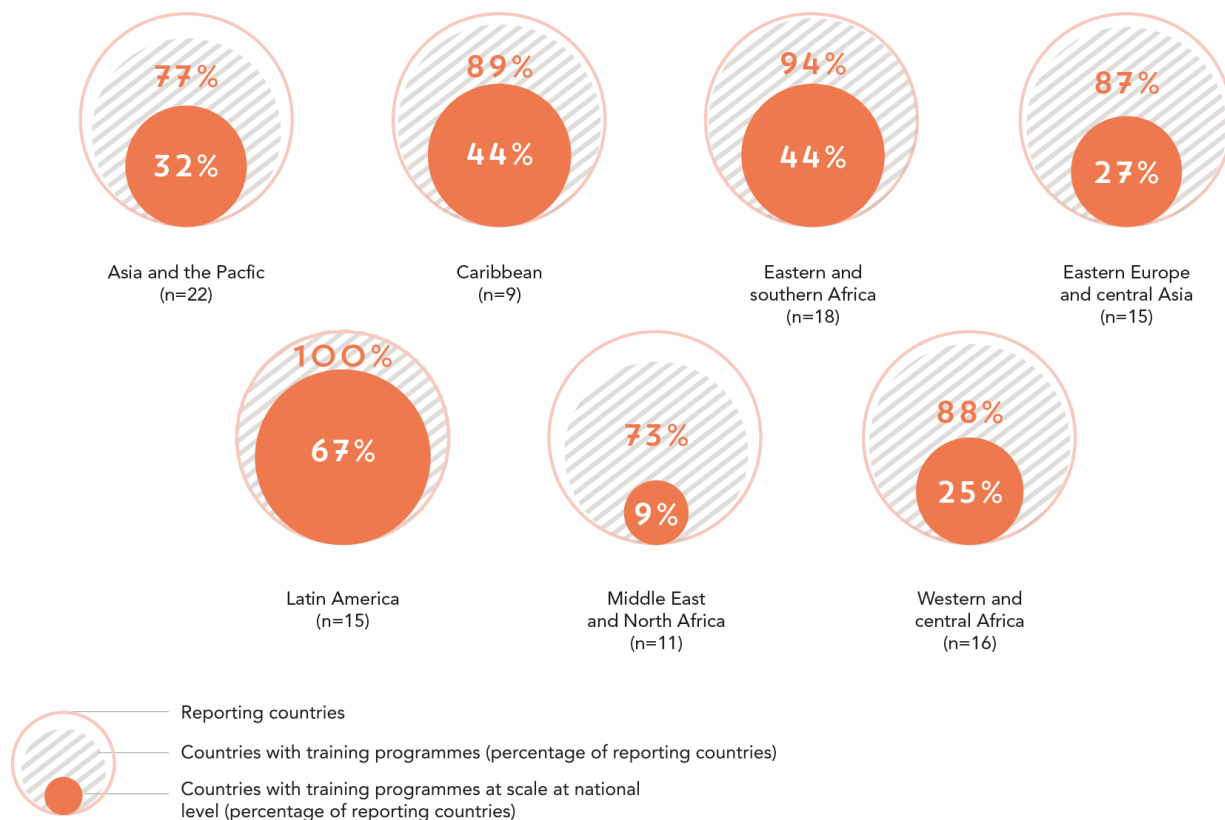


The cost of homophobia as a share of GDP and in value, per region, per year

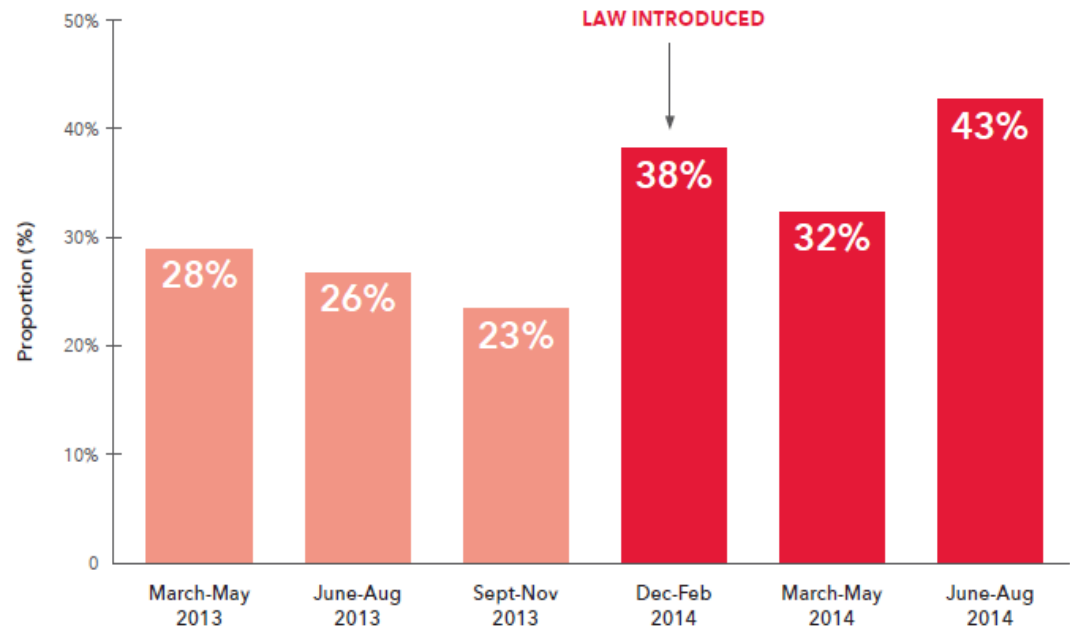

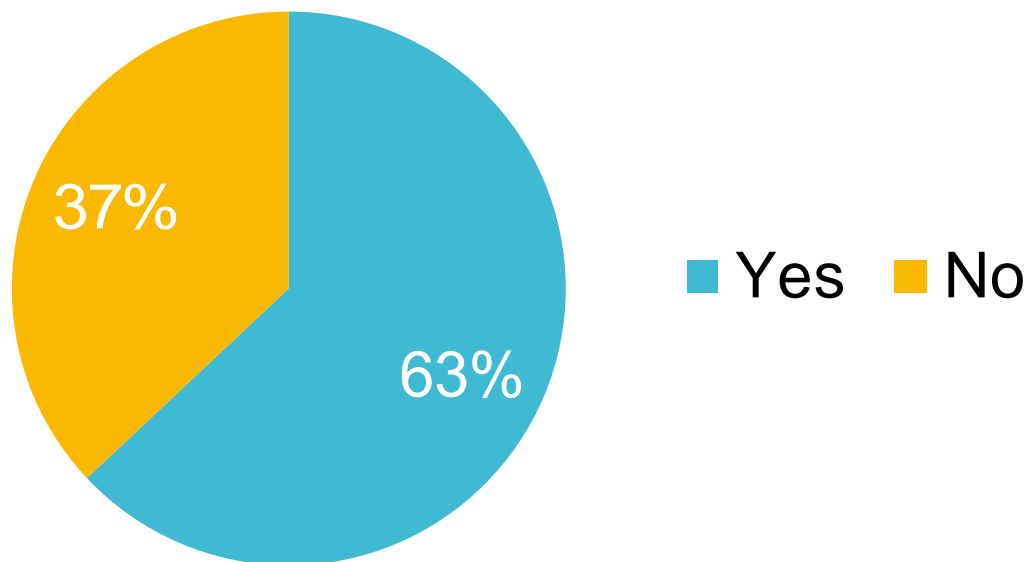
