NEXT PCB MEETINGS

The Next PCB meetings paper presents:

- Themes selected by the PCB Bureau for the thematic segments of the 48th and 49th PCB meetings
- Dates for the 52nd and 53rd PCB meetings in 2023



Process for selection of themes by PCB Bureau:

- September: Call for proposals of themes sent to PCB
- 28 September: initial deadline to submit proposals
- 5 October: final deadline after extension
- 12 November: PCB Bureau considered the proposals submitted



Proposals for thematic segment received by the PCB Bureau :

- COVID-19 and HIV: sustaining HIV gains and building back better and fairer HIV responses (WHO, supported by Brazil, UK, PCB NGOs, NAC Executive Directors/CEOs of GPC member countries, and all cosponsors) (Combined proposal at Bureau request)
- Meeting the needs of the unreached and promoting their rights: the case of people with disabilities (UNFPA)



Proposed themes were considered on basis of 4 criteria:

- 1. Broad relevance
- 2. Responsiveness
- 3. Focus
- 4. Scope for action



Given the quality and timeliness of the proposals, the Bureau has selected the following two proposals for consideration:

- COVID-19 and HIV: sustaining HIV gains and building back better and fairer HIV responses— for the thematic segment of the 48th PCB meeting in June 2021
- What does the regional and country-level data tell us, are we listening, and how can we better leverage that data and related technology to meet our 2020 and 2030 goals? - for the thematic segment of the 49th PCB meeting in December 2021

 - For the office of Rapporteur, United States of America has expressed written interest to the Secretariat (received 20 November 2020)
