#### 2. TRAVEL AND VISA ARRANGEMENTS

#### 2.1 General travel information to Chiang Mai

# 2.1.1 Note with regards to arrival date in Chiang Mai

When commencing travel arrangements, travellers should keep in mind that the PCB will be preceded by a PCB field visit, which will take place on Monday, 12 December 2022 from 08:00 to 14:00 (UTC+7) and Tuesday, 13 December from 07:30 to 12:00 (UTC+7).

### 2.1.2 Travel to Chiang Mai

The international airport in Bangkok is called Suvarnabhumi. Your international and domestic flights to/from Chiang Mai will arrive and depart at/from this airport. Those delegates who wish to stop over in Bangkok can take domestic flights to Chiang Mai from either Suvarnabhumi or Don Muang airports. There are a number of daily flights to Chiang Mai from both airports. *Chiang Mai International Airport* provides services for both domestic and international flights.

Those who have checked flights through to Chiang Mai, when the plane lands at Suvarnabhumi airport, should walk through to the transfer area; get the onward boarding pass (if not received already) at the TG International transfer area; proceed to the immigration counters (at the transfer area) to clear immigration; and, to then walk to the domestic counters behind the immigration area. Your luggage will be available for collection at the international section of the Chiang Mai airport.

#### 2.1.3 Airport pick-up and drop-off

The PCB Chair delegation is pleased to inform you that **in-person participants** at the 51st PCB meeting **will be provided upon request with (free of charge) airport transfers from and to Chiang Mai Airport**.

For those who have booked an airport transfer before the deadline of Friday, 2 December 2022, kindly note that these airport transfers are only for <u>travels taking place between December 11</u> and 17.

All airport transfers occurring before or after these dates must be booked <u>directly with the Shangri-La Hotel</u>.

# 2.1.4 Visa

Attention is drawn to the provisions in force regarding entry into Thailand. Delegates will need to check the requirements based on their nationality, passport type and current location. Any participants intending to travel on a diplomatic or UN Laissez Passer (UNLP) may still require a visa on the basis of their nationality.

Delegates requiring a <u>UNAIDS visa support letter</u> to obtain a Thai visa are kindly invited to indicate this during their Indico registration for the 51st PCB meeting by carefully providing the following information in the requested section: last name, first name, title, institution, date and place of birth, passport number, expiry date, date and place of issuance, and by attaching a copy of the passport at the earliest in order that action can be taken as soon as possible.

Visa procedures can be rigorous and may take longer than expected. The application must be submitted in good time. Before requesting a UNAIDS visa support letter, participants are advised to contact the nearest Thai embassy or consulate to determine whether they require a visa.

All travelers requiring a visa must have a valid passport with at least six months before the expiration date.

#### 2. 2 For UNAIDS Funded Delegates

# <u>2.2.1 Travel arrangements for eligible PCB members in accordance with</u> Modus Operandi:

In accordance with the PCB Modus Operandi, UNAIDS will cover the travel costs and per diem in connection with the attendance at this meeting for one representative from each developing country, from each country with an economy in transition and a representative from each of the nongovernmental organizations represented on the Board.

Kindly note that in the interest of cost effectiveness and time, the Secretariat strongly encourage delegates to send their names and contact details at least three weeks before the start of the meeting. The final deadline for receipt is close of business on **Monday**, **7 November 2022**.

#### 2.2.2 Accommodation

Reservations will be made for you at the Shangri-La. Please do not call the hotel directly to arrange or change your reservations. Once your travel itinerary has been received changes can be made to your booking by contacting <a href="mailto:reservations.slcm@shangri-la.com">reservations.slcm@shangri-la.com</a>. Private deviations will have to be arranged directly with the hotel.

UNAIDS funded delegates will have to pay the hotel bill directly at the hotel during check-in or check-out.

#### 2. 3. 1 Accommodation

#### 3. PCB FIELD VISIT FOR PCB MEMBERS ATTENDING IN-PERSON

The 2022 UNAIDS PCB field visit will take place on Monday, 12 December 2022 from 08:00 to 14:00 (UTC+7) and Tuesday, 13 December from 07:30 to 12:00 (UTC+7).

The 2022 UNAIDS PCB Field Visit is organized by the Thai Government with the support of national partners at all levels. The Field Visit is a great opportunity for board members to experience programmatic implementation while interacting with frontline implementers, communities and people infected with and affected by HIV. Moreover, the planned field visits are directly related to the issues to be discussed at the 51st UNAIDS PCB meeting.

#### 4. BADGE AND INFORMATION DESK

A UNAIDS welcome desk will be open at the Shangri-La as of **Sunday 11 December 2022, from 14h00-17h00 (UTC+7)**, where access badges and further information will be distributed to delegates. The desk will be situated on the ground floor of the Shangri-La.

As previously mentioned, delegates must present the original registration form sent beforehand to the conference Secretariat and their national identification card or passport. On the first day of the conference, there could be a bit of a wait, so participants are advised to arrive in good time.

The badges must be worn and visible at all times and access to the meeting rooms can be denied to anyone not wearing a badge.

The latest COVID-19 measures will be shared through email with the participants, who have indicated in their registration to join the meeting in person, closer to the meeting date.

#### 5. CATERING SERVICES

One or two coffee break(s) and one lunch (per day) will be provided at the Shangri-La for all delegates on all four meeting days (13-16 December 2022).

Ahead of drafting sessions, an extended coffee break will be provided to drafting group members.

A PCB reception will be held on Tuesday, 13 December 2022 from 18:00 to 20:00 (UTC+7) at the Shangri-La Hotel. All delegates who indicated in-person participation will receive further information closer to the 51<sup>st</sup> PCB meeting dates.

Dietary restrictions communicated to the UNAIDS Secretariat have been conveyed to the Shangri-La Hotel, which will ensure that a variety of catering options are available.

# 6. MEDICAL SERVICES AND SECURITY

The Shangri-La clinic is available to meeting participants needing urgent medical attention. The reception desk should be contacted the soonest in need of medical care.

Chiang Mai is overall a safe place. ## 7. CURRENCY, LANGUAGE AND LOCAL TIME

- Thai is the official language, but English is widely spoken throughout Thailand.
- Local time in Thailand is Universal Time Coordinated (UTC) +7 hours.
- The unit of currency in Thailand is the Baht (THB).

Facilities for the exchange of foreign currencies are available at the banks and authorized money changers. Credit cards are also widely accepted. The rate of exchange in October 2022 is:

#### 8. ELECTRIC CURRENT

The voltage of electrical current in Thailand is 220 volts – AC 50 HZ.

<u>Important:</u> please ensure you bring an international plug adapter with you. No adapters, phone or laptop chargers will be provided on site.

#### 9. COVID-19 MEASURES

Masks remain mandatory in the conference rooms until further notice. PCB participants are equally requested to wear masks on the compound of the Shangri-La Hotel. However, the requirement to wear masks has been lifted elsewhere on the hotel premises.

All persons on the Shangri-La Hotel premises continue to be encouraged to follow safety measures, such as regular hand washing and keeping safe distances.

#### 11. WEATHER

The first month of the winter, December, is also a moderately hot month in Chiang Mai, Thailand, with an average temperature fluctuating between 15.7°C (60.3°F) and 28.6°C (83.5°F).

# • Rainfall

In Chiang Mai, in December, it is raining for 1 day, with typically 15.9mm (0.63") of accumulated precipitation. In Chiang Mai, during the entire year, the rain falls for 113 days and collects up to 1130.6mm (44.51") of precipitation.

#### Daylight

December has the shortest days of the year in Chiang Mai, with an average of 11h and 1min of daylight.

On the first day of the month, sunrise is at 06:40 and sunset at 17:45. On the last day of December, sunrise is at 06:56 and sunset at 17:57 +07.

#### Sunshine

In December, the average sunshine is 8.5h.
