NEXT PCB MEETINGS



The Next PCB meetings paper presents:

- Themes selected by the PCB Bureau for the thematic segments of the 54th and 55th PCB meetings in 2024
- Dates for the 58th and 59th PCB meetings in 2026



Process for selection of themes by PCB Bureau:

- July 2023: Call for proposals of themes sent to PCB
- 15 September 2023: initial deadline to submit proposals
- 22 September 2023: final deadline after extension
- 9 October and 9 November 2023: PCB Bureau considered and discussed the 10 proposals submitted and agreed on the 2 topics for 2024.



10 proposals in total received and considered:

- 1. Elimination of vertical transmission of HIV, Syphilis and Hepatitis B;
- 2. Improving actions for care of children living with HIV;
- 3. Ending AIDS among children: Progress & Strategies;
- 4. Finding the "missing" men and boys in the HIV treatment cascade;
- 5. Approaches for making a vaccine for HIV-infection and providing equal access to vaccine prevention services;



10 proposals in total received and considered: (Cont.)

6. Scientific innovations in HIV: while a vaccine has not been created yet;

7. HIV and emerging sexually transmitted infections: maintaining sexual health in PLHIV;

8. Addressing inequalities in children and adolescents to End AIDS in 2030;

9. Community Leadership and Community-led Responses: their role in the response to HIV as a central agent in research, monitoring and political advocacy;

10. Sustaining the gains of the global HIV response to 2030 and beyond.



Proposed themes were considered on basis of 4 criteria:

- **1. Broad relevance**
- 2. Responsiveness
- 3. Focus
- 4. Scope for action

Given the quality and timeliness of the proposals, the Bureau has selected the following two combined proposals for consideration:

- Sustaining the gains of the global HIV response to 2030 and beyond for the thematic segment of the 54th PCB meeting in June 2024
- Addressing inequalities in children and adolescents to End AIDS by 2030 for the thematic segment of the 55th PCB meeting in December 2024

- The Modus Operandi foresees the PCB to elect the current Vice-Chair, Kenya, to the position of Chair for a term of one year starting on 1 January 2024.
- This meeting of the PCB Coordinating Board must also elect a Vice-Chair and a Rapporteur for a term of one year starting 1 January 2024.
- On Tuesday 7 November 2023, the Secretariat received an expression of interest from **Brazil** for the position of Vice-Chair.
- On Tuesday 14 November 2023, the Secretariat received an expression of interest from **Netherlands** for the position of Rapporteur.

New delegates for PCB NGO Delegation 2024

- The Orientation, Accountability and Recruitment (OAR) Working Group of the NGO Delegation together with the Communication and Consultation Facility (CCF), manages the annual process of recruiting incoming Delegates to fill in the slots vacated by outgoing Delegates.
- In 2023, seven delegates were eligible to continue for a third year in the NGO Delegation. Five of these delegates were granted a thirdyear extension in line with the maximum term of service conforming to ECOSOC resolution 1995/2.
- Following this process, the NGO Delegation confirmed a total of two vacancies to serve the term from 2024 to 2025.
