
TUBERCULOSIS AND HIV

IN 2022, AN ESTIMATED
10.6 MILLION PEOPLE FELL ILL
WITH TB AND 1.3 MILLION
DIED FROM THE DISEASE



People living with HIV are up to 16 [14–18] times more likely to fall ill with TB

ANNUAL GLOBAL FUNDING FOR DEVELOPMENT AND RESEARCH ON TUBERCULOSIS IS US\$ 1.0 BILLION SHORT OF WHAT IS REQUIRED



TB IS THE **LEADING CAUSE OF DEATH** AMONG PEOPLE LIVING WITH HIV

UNAIDS IS WORKING WITH PARTNERS TO REDUCE TB-RELATED DEATHS AMONG PEOPLE LIVING WITH HIV BY 80% (COMPARED TO A 2010 BASELINE) AND THAT 90% OF PEOPLE LIVING WITH HIV RECEIVE PREVENTIVE TREATMENT FOR TUBERCULOSIS BY 2025

TB is curable: the combination of TB treatment and ART is estimated to have averted 6.4 million deaths between 2010 and 2022

In 2022, only 54% of people living with HIV estimated to have developed TB received both TB treatment and ART
